NC 4-H CONGRESS

The North Carolina 4-H Congress is coming up! This annual teen event brings 4-Hers from across North Carolina for a four (4) day retreat at N.C. State University. Youth will get the college experience (staying in dorms, listening to college professor lectures, etc), do some fun team building activities (ziplining, horse riding, etc.), and youth leadership and citizenship activities (meet state representatives, community service projects, etc.)

WHERE: N.C. State University (Raleigh, NC) This is an overnight event and youth will be staying in dorms on campus. Dorms will be separated based on gender and youth from the same county will stay in the same dorm.

WHEN: Saturday, July 16 through Tuesday, July 19 (4 days, 3 nights)

COST: **Registration is \$400 per youth and adult.** This will include registration fees, t-shirts, meals, lodging, and activities.

We do have some funds thanks to Paper Clover with Tractor Supply which allows us to reduce the cost to **\$145 per youth participant.** Please reach out to Danny for this offer.

TRAVEL: Transportation to and from Congress from our Cooperative Extension Office will be provided.

Dinah Gore Healthy Food Challenge

The Dinah Gore 4-H Healthy Food Challenge is a contest that challenges a team of 3 4-H members to create a dish that will serve 3 people using a predetermined ingredient, food category, and items from the pantry. Once the ingredient is revealed, the team will have 40 minutes to prepare the dish, clean up and prepare their presentations for the judges. The team will make a presentation to the judges covering their dish, its health benefits and the nutrients that the dish provides to the body, about 10 minutes after the dish is ready. The event will be held July 29, 2022.

Registration is June 1 - July 1, and will close when slots are full. 5 teams per age group
