Don't miss out on this EGG-CITING Opportunity!!! The EGG-cellent Egg Contest is coming up!

This contest is for 4-H'ers with a flock of chickens that are currently laying eggs. Participants can submit up to 2 dozen eggs to be evaluated in both internal and external quality.

There are categories for PeeWee eggs (15 oz/dozen) up to Jumbot eggs (30 oz/dozen).
